This course is designed for beginners in computer cosmetic imaging, esthetic treatment planning and case presentations. Dr. Holt will demonstrate many examples through the use of Sci-Cam's Fx Software to enhance esthetic case presentations, i.e. bleaching and replacing missing or fractured teeth. Each participant will also work on a computer, learning how to bleach teeth, close diastemas, replace amalgam fillings with composites, place PFM crowns, replace missing teeth, perform anterior and posterior reconstructions and use digital photography to implement the computer assisted animation.
