### **Richard Kahn, DDS**

Dr. Kahn is celebrating his 40th anniversary of teaching full time at the USC School of Dentistry. He is an Associate Professor with tenure and is the Phillip Maurer Tennis Professor of Clinical Dentistry. He is presently Chairman of the Sections of Operative Dentistry and Fixed Prosthodontics in the Division of Primary Health Care. He has authored several teaching manuals and other education materials that are still being used at USC and other teaching

institutions. During his 40 years at USC he has received more than 15 teaching excellence awards from his students. In 2002 he was recognized by the Pierre Fauchard Academy for his lifetime teaching excellence. He is a Fellow of the International College of Dentists and the American College of Dentists. Dr. Kahn is one of the nation's most respected educators and has given numerous CE courses throughout the United States, Europe and Mexico.



### **Jose-Luis Ruiz, DDS, FAGD**

Dr. Ruiz is Course Director of the USC Advanced Esthetic Dentistry Continuum and Clinical Instructor at the USC School of Dentistry. He is a Fellow of the Academy of General Dentistry, Associate Instructor and Mentor at PCC Utah, teaching with Dr. Gordon Christensen, and an independent evaluator of dental products for CRA. Dr. Ruiz has been practicing General Dentistry in the Film Studio District of Los Angeles for over 13 years, where he treats many

stars and entertainers. Dr. Ruiz's esthetic makeovers have been featured on a number of television shows including NBC Channel 4 News, ABC 7 Vista LA and Channel 52 Telemundo, and he is regularly consulted on Esthetic Dentistry. ## SYNOPSIS

Dr. Kahn will thoroughly review the principles of tooth preparation for direct bonded composite restorations. He will discuss the principles and technique necessary to achieve predictable bonds to enamel and dentin while minimizing post-operative sensitivity. He will also review the technique for placement and finishing of composite restorations. Dr. Ruiz will follow and review the latest concepts on composite materials and bonding agents. He will also discuss the principles of color, shade-matching, and the use of tints and opaquers to achieve natural-looking restorations.

Participants in this hands-on course will have the opportunity to apply the principles discussed by Dr. Kahn and Dr. Ruiz, and will be able to work at USC's famous "Sim-lab", one of the most modern and realistic simulator facilities in California. Participants will also place and finish posterior direct composite restorations, class IV restorations and composite veneer restorations. At the end of the course, participants can take home a block set of finishing burs and diamonds, bonding materials, composites, polishing supplies, and other supplies valued at hundreds of dollars.
