L. Stephen Buchanan, DDS, FICD, FACD (USA)

Assistant Clinical Professor of Endodontics at the University of Southern California School of Dentistry, Los Angeles, California. Dr. Buchanan is a Diplomate of the American Board of Endodontics and a Fellow of the International and American Colleges of Dentists. He is known for his Micro CT anatomy research, his state-of-the-art technology presentations and his instrument designs. He maintains a private practice limited to Endodontics in Santa Barbara, California.

Topic: Technology and the art of endodontics: How invention created the specialty as it is today and directions that invention will take us tomorrow



Stephen Davis, DDS (USA)

Chief of Endodontics and Director of the Endodontic Residency Program at the VA Medical Center Long Beach, California. Dr. Davis graduated from UCLA School of Dentistry in 1978 and had practiced general dentistry for 13 years before entering the Endodontic Residency Program at the VA Medical Center Long Beach in 1991. He obtained his certificate in endodontics in 1993. From 1994 to 2000, Dr. Davis was director of the Division of Endodontics at the Medical University of South Carolina.

Fernando Goldberg, DDS, PhD (Argentina)

Professor and Chairman of the Department of Endodontics at the School of Dentistry of the USAL/AOA University, Buenos Aires, Argentina. Dr. Goldberg received his DDS degree from the University of Buenos Aires School of Dentistry in 1962 and his PhD in 1975. He is an Active Member of the American Association of Endodontists and has published more than 90 articles in different dental journals as well as three endodontic textbooks.

Pierre Machtou, DDS (France)

Professor of Endodontics at the University of Paris 7 School of Dentistry, Paris, France. Dr. Machtou is Past-Scientific Director of the French Endodontic Society, Past-General Secretary of the French Endodontic Society and the Charter President of the Parisian Study Club of Endodontology. He is also an Associate Editor of Endodontic Practice and a member of the Editorial Board of the International Endodontic Journal. He served as a member of the Education Committee of the European Society of Endodontology and the National Committee of the H. Schilder Chair in Endodontics. Dr. Machtou has lectured worldwide and authored 70 articles and numerous chapters in endodontic textbooks.

Ilan Rotstein, DDS (USA)

Associate Professor and Chair, Division of Surgical, Therapeutic and Bioengineering Sciences and Associate Dean for Continuing Oral Health Professional Education at the USC School of Dentistry, Los Angeles, California. Dr. Rotstein is Chair of the Research Committee of the International Federation of Endodontic Associations and a member of the Research and Scientific Affairs Committee of the American Association of Endodontists. Dr. Rotstein has published over 100 scientific articles and research abstracts in the dental literature as well as chapters in international endodontic textbooks.

Topic: The endodontic-periodontal continuum



James H. Simon, BA, DDS (USA)

Professor and Director of Advanced Endodontics at the University of Southern California School of Dentistry, Los Angeles, California. Dr. Simon was Chief of the Endodontic Section at the VA Medical Center, Long Beach, California, where he served as Director of the Endodontic Residency Program between 1968 and 2000. He is a Diplomate of the American Board of Endodontics, Past Director and President of the American Board of Endodontics, Fellow of the American College of Dentists and Fellow of the International College of Dentists. Dr. Simon has published many scientific articles and research abstracts as well as chapters in international endodontic textbooks.

Topic: The mystery of root resorption



Calvin Torneck, DDS (Canada)

Professor Emeritus at the University of Toronto Faculty of Dentistry, Toronto, Canada. Dr. Torneck was Chair of the Department of Endodontics and the Co-Director of the Graduate Endodontic Program. He is Past President of the Canadian Academy of Endodontics, the Ontario Society of Endodontists, the American Board of Endodontics and the Pulp Biology Section of the International Association for Dental Research. He is a recipient of the Ralph F. Sommer and the Louis I. Grossman Awards of the American Association of Endodontists. He has authored and co-authored 60 scientific papers, 5 endodontic teaching manuals, contributed chapters to 19 textbooks related to dental practice and dental science, and has lectured extensively throughout the world. Currently he maintains a private practice in Toronto, Canada.

Topic: A classification and description of periapical disease of endodontic origin



Martin Trope, DDS, MS, FRCDC (USA)

JB Freedland Professor in the Department of Endodontics at the University of North Carolina School of Dentistry. A noted authority in his field, Dr. Trope has been actively involved in clinical research in all phases of endodontics. Prior to coming to UNC, Dr. Trope was Chairman of the Department of Endodontology at Temple University, Philadelphia. Dr. Trope served as Director of the American Board of Endodontics and currently is editor-in-chief of two journals, Dental Traumatology and Endodontic Topics. He also serves on the Editorial Boards of many other journals. Dr. Trope's major research interests include dental trauma, clinical outcomes, and new diagnostic tests for pulpal and periapical disease. His work has been published in numerous journals and book chapters. In April 2002 he was awarded "The Louis I. Grossman Award" for cumulative publication of significant research by the American Association of Endodontists.
